INSTRUCTIONS

This form shall be executed and filed in Q1 (OIL FIELD) by the owner of the unit or the Office of the Oil Conservation Commission, depending upon whether or not oil or gas is produced. A separate certificate shall be filed for each time the unit is to be transported (i.e., from a unit). After said certificate has been approved by the Oil Conservation Commission, one copy shall be forwarded to the local oil field office, one copy retained by the property owner, and two copies retained by the Oil Conservation Commission.

A new certificate shall be filed to cover each change in operating conditions, such as change in the transporter, except that in the case of a temporary transporter, the transporter may move less than the allowable production for one month without the operator being required to file a new certificate; notify the Commission, the Commission District Office, and the transporter authorized by certificate of the Commission. By letter of the estimated amount of oil or gas to be moved by the transporter temporarily moving oil or gas from the unit and the date of the temporary transporter, and a copy of such notice shall also be furnished to the transporter. Such temporary transporter shall not move any more oil or gas than the estimated amount shown in said notice.

The certificate when properly executed and approved by the Oil Conservation Commission shall constitute a permit for pipe line connection and shall authorize the transporter to move oil and gas from the property named therein and shall remain in full force and effect until:

- a. A new ownership change;
- b. The transporter is changed; or
- c. The permit is cancelled by the Commission.

If any of the rules and regulations of the Oil Conservation Commission have not been complied with at the same time this report is filed, the operator shall file the heading "REMARKS."

In all cases when this certificate is filed to cover a change in ownership, the transporter designated to move oil or gas shall file the heading "REMARKS" by the previous owner or operator and the transporter shall not authorize to transport oil or gas.

A separate unit shall be filed to cover each producing well which is to be drilled by the Oil Conservation Commission.
