INSTRUCTIONS

This form shall be executed and filed in the OIL CONSERVATION District Office of the Oil Conservation Commission, covering each unit in which oil or gas is produced. This certificate shall be issued to and held by the transporter to transport oil or gas from a unit. After said certificate has been approved by the Oil Conservation Commission, one copy shall be forwarded to the Commission, one copy returned to the operator, and two copies retained by the transporter.

A new certificate shall be filed to cover each change in operation of a unit, except change in ownership, except that in the case of a temporary transporter, the transporter having less than the allowable production for one year, upon completion of the operation shall, upon filing a new certificate notify the Oil Conservation Commission District Office and the transporter authorized by certificate of the Commission, by letter of the estimated amount of oil or gas to be moved by the transporter temporarily moving oil or gas from the unit and the transporter shall furnish a temporary transporter and a copy of such notice shall also be furnished to the transporter. Such temporary transporter shall not move any more oil or gas than the estimated amount shown in said notice.

This certificate when properly executed and approved by the Oil Conservation Commission shall constitute a permit for pipe line connection and shall authorize transport oil and gas from the property named therein and shall remain in full force and effect until:

- a. Operating ownership change
- b. The transporter is changed or
- c. The permit is cancelled by the Commission

If any of the rules and regulations of the Oil Conservation Commission have not been complied with at the same time this report is filed, the transporter shall file the heading "REMARKS."

In all cases where this certificate is filed to cover a change in ownership or change in the transporter designated to move oil or gas, the heading "REMARKS" of the previous owner or operator and the transporter shall be attached and shall show the transporter authorized to transport oil or gas.

A separate report shall be filed to cover each producing unit approved by the Oil Conservation Commission.
