INSTRUCTIONS

This form shall be completed and filed in Quarterly Production Report Form No. 1, Office of the Oil Conservation Commission, concerning each unit in which oil or gas is produced. A separate certificate shall be filed for each unit in which there is to transport oil or gas from a unit. After said certificate has been approved by the Oil Conservation Commission, one copy shall be forwarded to the local office of the Commission, one copy retained for the producing unit, and two copies retained by the Oil Conservation Commission.

A new certificate shall be filed to cover each change in operating conditions and each change in the transporter, except that in the case of a temporary transporter the transporter may not less than the allowable production for one month beyond the operation shall, in completing a new certificate notify the Oil Conservation Commission District Office, and the transporter authorized by certificate of the Oil Conservation Commission, by letter of the estimated amount of oil or gas to be transported by the transporter temporarily by moving oil or gas from the unit and the transporter shall file a temporary transporter and a copy of such notice shall also be furnished to the local transporter. Such temporary transporter shall not move any more oil or gas than the estimated amount shown in said notice.

This certificate when properly executed and approved by the Oil Conservation Commission shall constitute a permit for pipe line connection and authority to transport oil and gas from the property named therein and shall remain in full force and effect until:

- a. An operating ownership change;
- b. The transporter is changed; or
- c. The permit is cancelled by the Commission.

If any of the rules and regulations of the Oil Conservation Commission have not been complied with at the same time this report is filed, the transporter shall file the heading "REMARKS".

In all cases where this certificate is filed to cover a change in ownership or a change in the transporter designated to move oil or gas, the transporter shall file "REMARKS" by the previous owner or operator and the transporter shall be authorized to transport oil or gas.

A separate report shall be filed to cover each producing unit in which there is to be a change in the transporter designated to move oil or gas from the unit, and shall be filed by the Oil Conservation Commission.
