DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

This well was drilled to 3615' when a mill was lost at 2358' and could not be fished. Tubing was run to 2600' and the hole circulated with 10# mud and 25 sacks of cement were spotted on bottom on 6/19/47. On 6/21/47 the 8 5/8" was shot at 700' and 654' of 8 5/8" casing pulled. Twenty-five sacks of cement were spotted at 650'. A top hole plug of 25 sacks of cement was then run with a joint of 4" line pipe left as a marker 4' above the surface. Job was completed 6/23/47.
