DETAILS OF WORK

1192 ft. of 8-5/8" O. D. casing and set at 1206 ft.

String #1 (Millerburger) Ran 7629 ft. of 2-7/8" O. D. casing (6.1C) set at 7610 ft. Cements circulated. Plug set 7635 ft.

String #2 (Blimey) Ran 7629 ft. of 2-7/8" O. D. casing (6.1C) set at 7640 ft. Plug at 1132 ft. RA collar and 4 ft. sub at 5516 ft.

Cement both strings simultaneously with 2,000 sacks of Inco M Gel. Final 1,000 sacks contained 3/4 of 1% CFR-2. Pumped down plug with 500 gallons of acetic acid and 32 lbs. of water in each string. Job complete 7:00 A.M. May 17, 1963.

Tested both strings for 30 minutes with 1500 psi from 5:00 to 5:30 A.M. May 18, 1963. Both job drilled plugs and retested with 1500 psi for 30 minutes. Tested OK.

Job completed 5:00 A.M. May 18, 1963.

Plan and that this plan of work must receive approval in writing by the Geological Survey before operations may be commenced.
