DETAILS OF WORK

It is our intention to drill a well at the above location to an approximate depth of 8,900' to attempt a completion in the Bone Spring horizon. All casing points will be cemented in accordance with approved methods of the U.S.G.S. and any special requirements will be complied with.

It is planned to use the following casing pattern: 12 1/4" hole, 8 5/8" casing to be set at 1200' and cemented w/1,000 sacks cement. Cement is to circulate. 7 7/8" hole, 5 1/2" casing to be set at 8900' and cemented w/860 sacks cement and 90 gal. latex. Cement is to return to 4000'.

Permission is requested to perform the above work and to produce this well upon completion.

I understand that this plan of work must receive approval in writing by the Geological Survey before operations may be commenced.

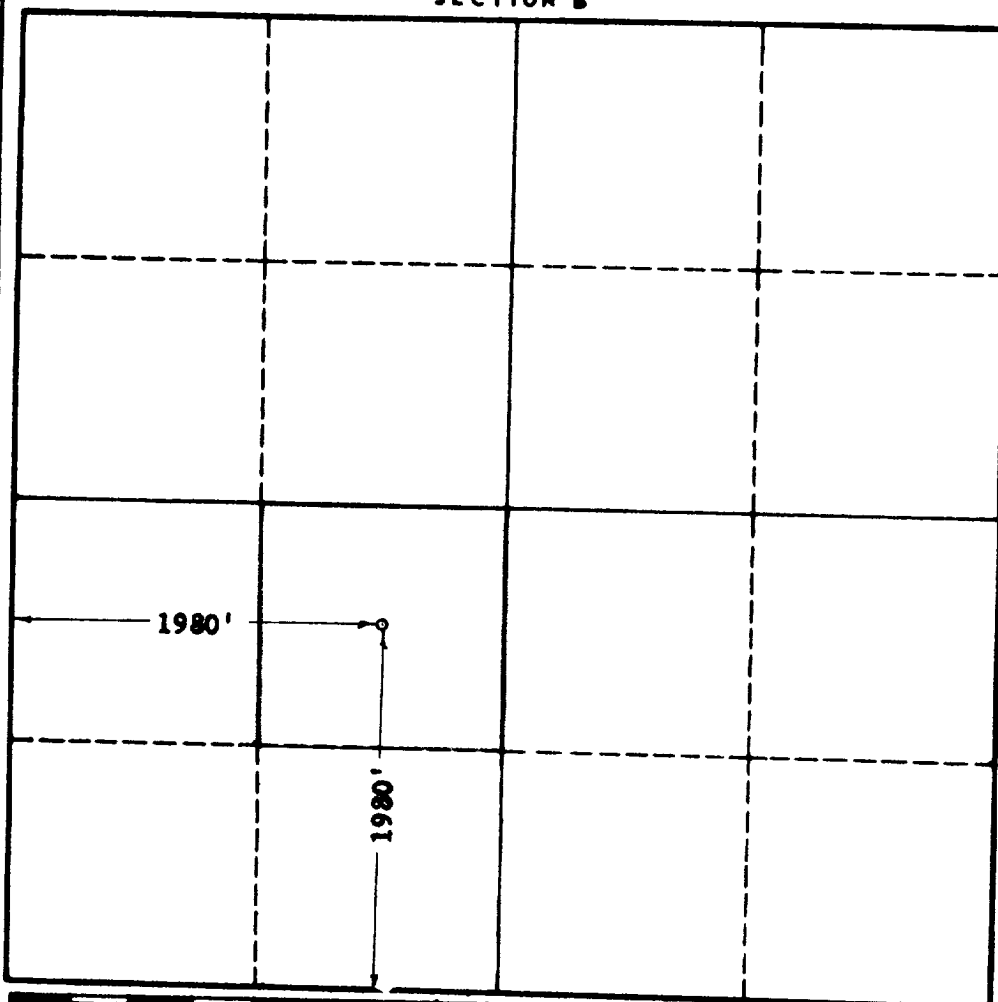
