DIAGRAMMATIC SKETCH SHOWING DUAL INSTALLATION (STANDARD)

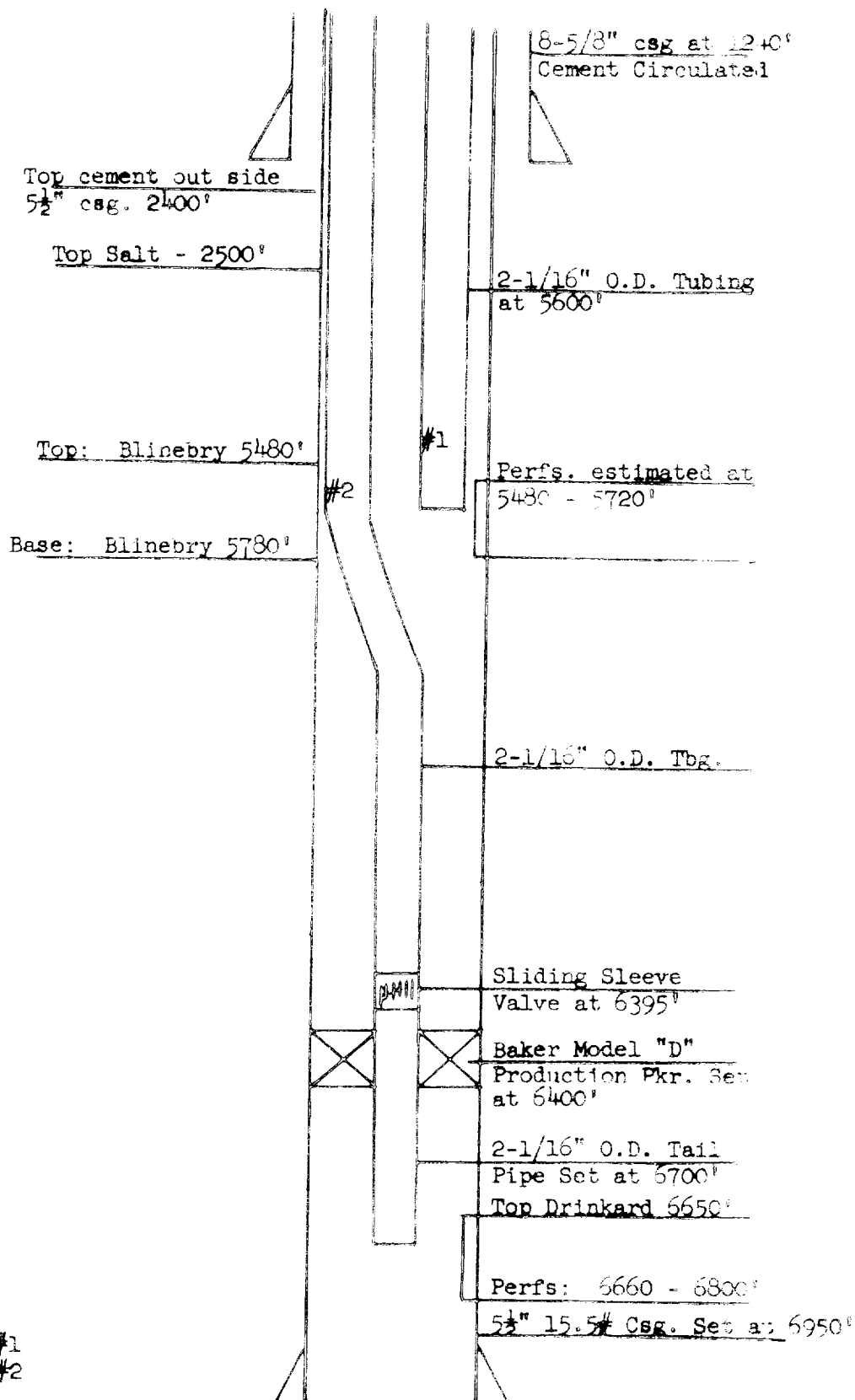
