Gentlemen:

TEXACO Inc. respectfully requests Administrative approval of an exception to New Mexico Oil Conservation Commission Rule 107(e) for the A. H. Blinebry (NCT-1) Well No. 19. This well is a proposed single tubingless completion in the Blinebry (Oil) Pool, and is located 660 feet from the north line and 660 feet from the west line of Section 29, Township 22 south, Range 38 east, Lea County, New Mexico.

The production casing string will be 2-7/8 inch O.D. set at 7,000 feet in a 7-7/8 inch hole. Completion will be through perforations from approximately 5600 feet to 5750 feet in the Blinebry formation. No corrosion or paraffin problems have been encountered in this pool.

This zone has been approved by the New Mexico Oil Conservation Commission as a tubingless completion in this area. An instance is TEXACO Inc. A.H. Blinebry (NCT-1) Well No. 18.

Attached is a diagrammatic sketch of the proposed tubingless completion and a plat showing the location of all wells on the A. H. Blinebry (NCT-1) Lease and all offset wells along with the names and addresses of all offset operators. A copy of this request is being sent this date to all offset operators by registered mail.

tions from approximately 500 feet to 550 feet in the Blinnery for-
mation. No corrosion or gasification problems have been encountered in
this pool.

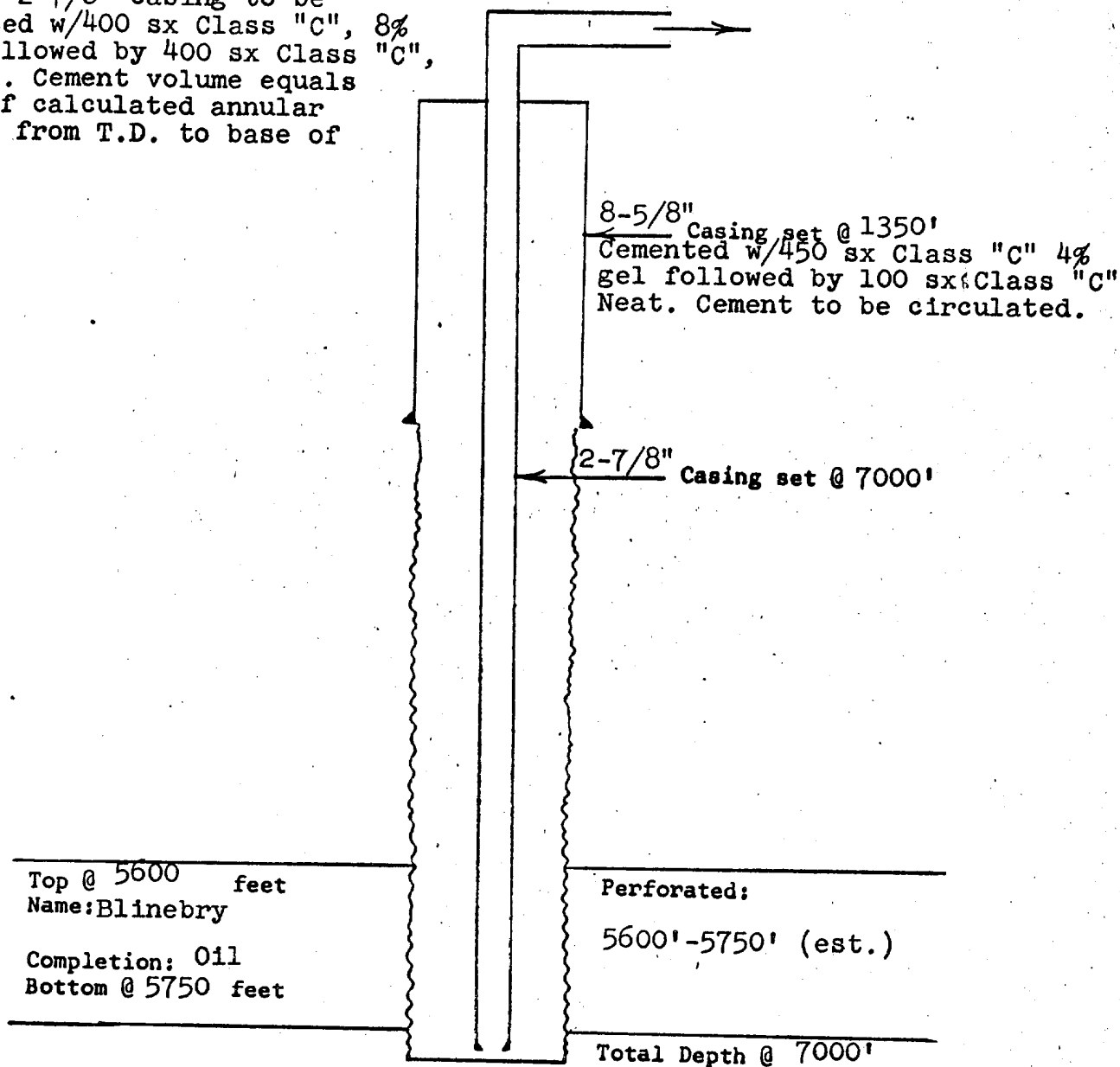

Diagrammatic Sketch of Single Tubingless Completion

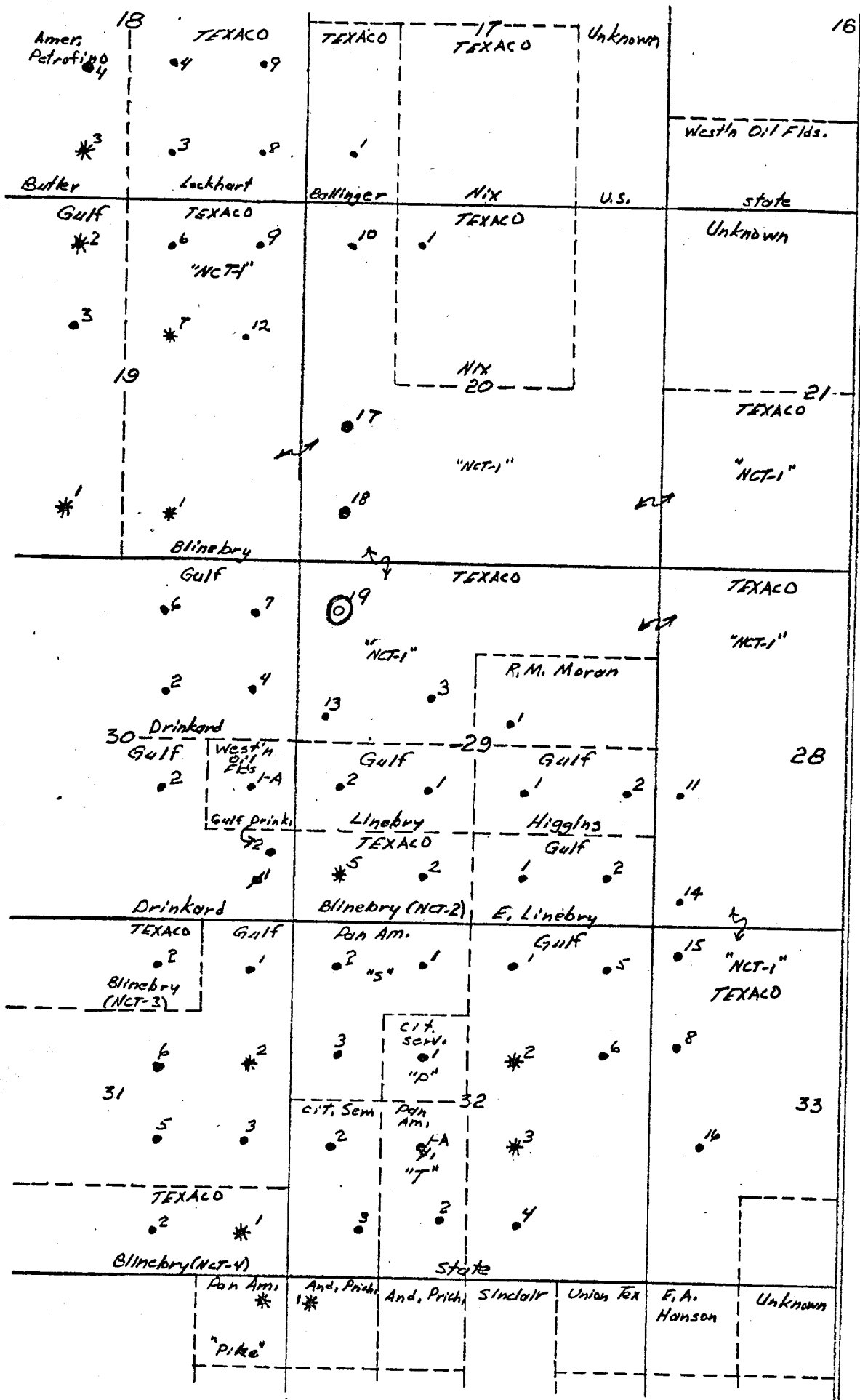
