Gentlemen:

TEXACO Inc. respectfully requests administrative approval for the single tubingless completion of W. L. Nix Well No. 4 in the Drinkard Pool. This well is located 660 feet from the North line and 2310 feet from the East line of Section 20, Township 22 South, Range 38 East, Lea County, New Mexico.

Surface casing consists of 8-5/8 inch pipe set at 1387 feet and cemented to surface with 430 sacks of Trinity Lite Water followed by 100 sacks of Class 'C' neat cement. Production casing consists of 2-7/8 inch pipe set at total depth of 7275 feet and cemented with 750 sacks of Trinity Lite Water and 500 sacks of Class 'C', 4% gel, cement. Cement volume equals 169% of the calculated annular space from total depth to the base of the salt at 2370 feet.

No corrosion or paraffin problems have been encountered in wells previously completed in the Drinkard Pool and previous tubingless completion in the Drinkard Pool was authorized for TEXACO Inc. W. L. Nix Well No. 2.

In view of the aforementioned, authorization for the requested completion would be appreciated.

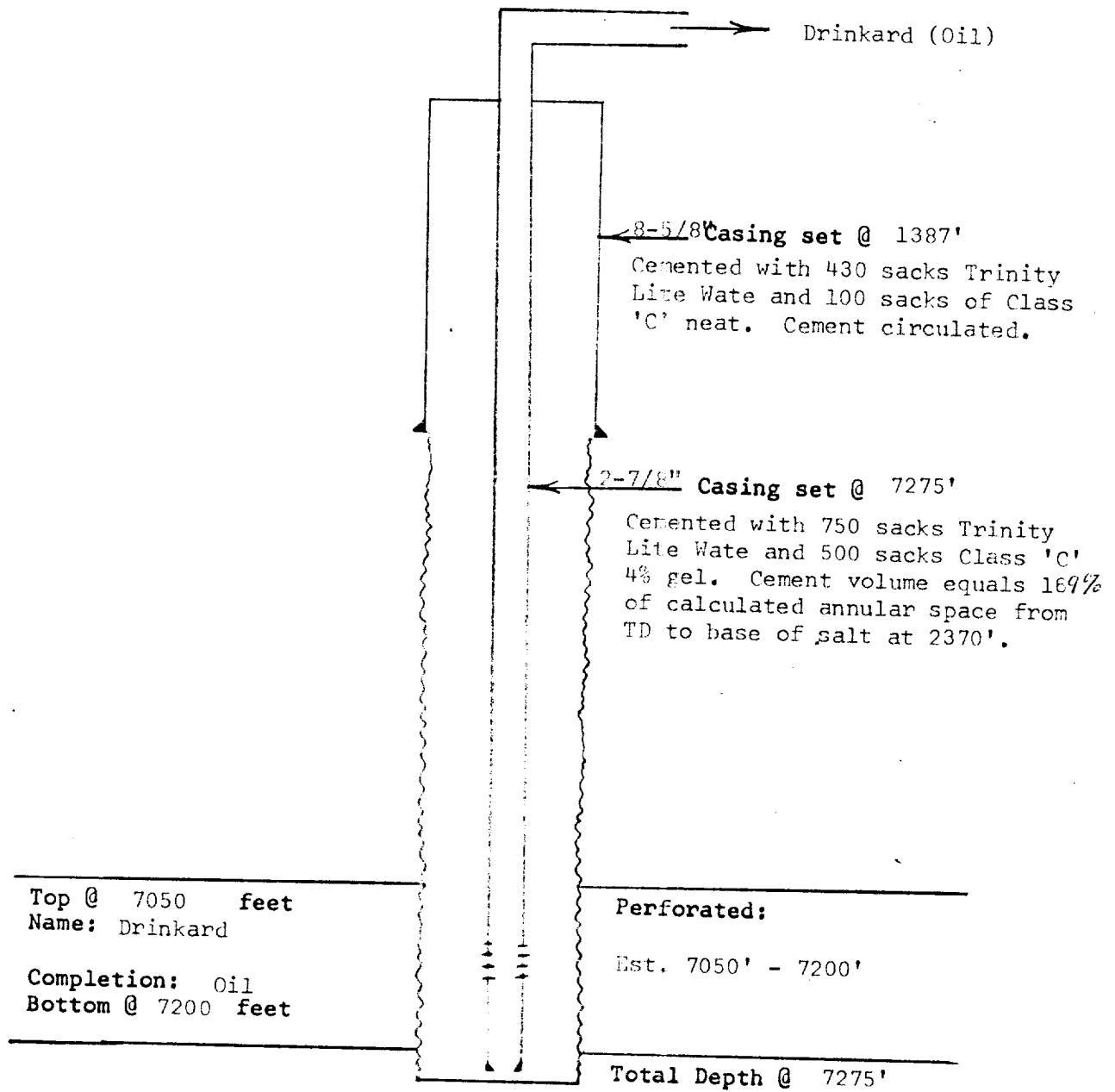

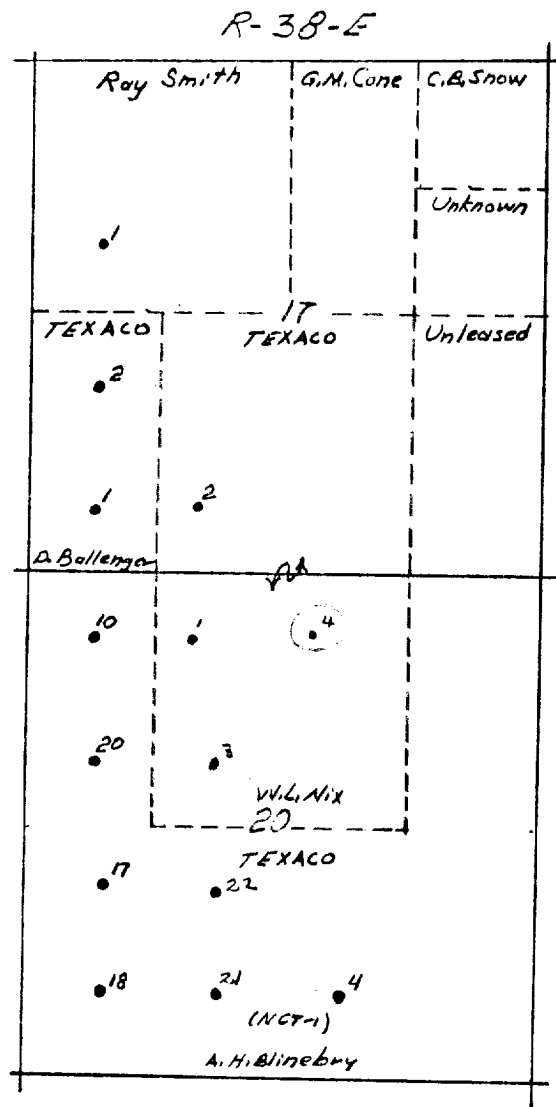
