Gentlemen:

Your application for authority to triply complete your J. L. Muncy Well No. 4 located in Unit H of Section 24, Township 22 South, Range 37 East, NMPM, Lea County, New Mexico, has been received by the Commission and has been placed in the suspense file for the 20-day waiting period required by Rule 112-A.

Your application for multiple completion is eligible for administrative consideration, however, as Order No. R-1232 (Case No. 1487) authorized a non-standard 160-acre gas proration unit in the Tubb Gas Pool to be dedicated to the J. L. Muncy Well No. 2, located 1980 feet FSL and 1980 feet FWL of the above-described Section 24, the Commission's Legal Department has advised it will be necessary to have a hearing to approve re-dedication of the non-standard unit to the J. L. Muncy Well No. 4. If you desire that this matter be set for an Examiner Hearing at the earliest possible date, or, if this should cause a change of your intention to complete the J. L. Muncy No. 4 as proposed, please notify the Santa Fe Office of the Commission.
