
Dear Sir:

We have filed Form O-104 with the Hobbs Office changing the operator of the captioned lease from Yuronka and Chandler to Mabee Royalties, Inc., as per Oil Conservation Commission Orders No. P-3263-A and No. R-3388-A.

We have not been able to secure a connection for our casinghead gas because Skelly Oil Company, our contract purchaser, has been unable to secure right-of-way to our property. They have today informed us that they will be unable to secure such right-of-way, and will release us from the contract (see enclosed correspondence).

We are now negotiating with Warren Petroleum Corporation and will make every effort to obtain a connection within the next thirty days.
