To comply with your request on the above referenced well, we seek your approval to test the casing to 600# for 30 minutes and check the Braden Head for pressure and leave the well in the temporary abandon status for a period of six months ending on October 1, 1997. At that time we will have the well on production or plugged and abandoned according to your specifications. The well has a cast iron bridge plug with a cement cap on the plug set above all perforations. The hole is loaded with treated fluid above the bridge plug and no leaks or pollution is present.
