As provided by Section F of Rule 104 of the New Mexico Oil Conservation Commission, Anadarko Production Company hereby makes application for an exception to Sub-Section I of Section C of Rule 104 for its Wortham "C" Well No. 2, South Eunice San Andres Pool, Lea County, New Mexico at an unorthodox location 1877.7' FNL and 2407' FEL of Section 11-T22S-R37E due to topographical conditions at the standard location.

To support this application, we are enclosing three (3) copies each of (1) NMOCC Form C-102 showing the proposed location with an insert of topographic conditions and (2) a plat showing offset operators to the proposed location and proration unit.

Written waivers of objection to this application have been requested from Marathon Oil Company, Sohio Petroleum Company, Texas Pacific Oil Company, Mobil Oil Company, and Shell Oil Company, being

all of the direct offset operators. Our original request of each of the referenced operators was to send the requested waiver to your Hobbs office. This procedure is in error, and by telephone, we have requested each waiver to be directed to Santa Fe.
