Gentlemen:

Please find attached Form C-104 concerning a recompletion of the subject well in the Granite Wash formation.

When the subject well was drilled the Granite Wash formation was perforated and acidized through the perforations as reported on the current C-104. Production was not deemed commercial at that time, the Granite Wash was isolated with a bridge plug, and a completion was made in the Drinkard formation.

The Granite Wash has been reopened and fractured with commercial production resulting and the Drinkard formation is still open to the annulus, but shut in. A hearing is being requested to complete the well as a tubing - casing dual. The Drinkard shall remain shut in until the dual completion application be approved.
