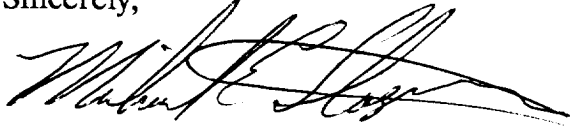
I have reviewed the subject application and feel additional data and explanation is needed before authorization can be granted. My records indicate that the Elliott B-12 Well No. 2 located in Unit D of said Section 12 is producing from the Tubb Pool as an oil well with the NW/4 NW/4 dedicated therein, forming a standard 40-acre oil spacing and proration unit. It is apparent that this well prevents Hendrix from forming a standard 160-acre gas spacing and proration unit in the NW/4 for the subject application (see Rule 2(a)3 of the Special Rules and Regulations for the Tubb Oil and Gas Pool as promulgated by Division Order No. R-8170, as amended). Is there a reason why a 120-acre non-standard gas spacing and proration unit could not be formed by including both the NE/4 NW/4 and SW/4 NW/4 of said Section 12 to the subject 40-acre tract?

If a 120-acre non-standard gas spacing and proration unit cannot be accomplished for some reason, then did you adequately notify all off-set operators owning interests in the NE/4 NW/4 and SW/4 NW/4 of said Section 12 of this application (Rule 2(a)4)? If this is the case, please verify.

In either case, please provide an up-to-date and reasonable plat showing all of the off-setting operators to the NW/4 of Section 12.

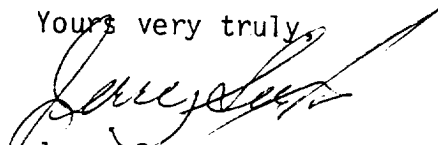

Dear Mr. Stogner:

There is no reason a 120 acre non-stand proration unit consisting of the E/2 NW/4 and SW/4 NW/4 of Section 12 could not be formed. The acreage is part Federal and part Fee, and unitization would take some time to accomplish. We have farmed in part of the Tubb rights in this 40 acre tract, however, and have very little time to accomplish the work. If the Tubb production capability warrants it, we can pursue enlarging the proration unit in the future.

We, along with the Trust U/D Donaldson Brown, are the leasehold owners of the SW/4 NW/4 and NE/4 NW/4. The Trust is also a partner in the Hinton No. 11.

Enclosed is a plat showing offset operators. Based upon an interpretation of the Offset Notification rule to mean "the offset operators to a standard proration unit", it appears we did not notify enough operators. Those letters are being mailed today.

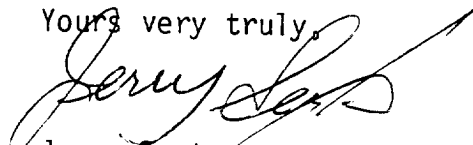

Gentlemen:

John H. Hendrix Corporation respectfully requests administrative approval for a non-standard 40 acre gas proration unit consisting of the SE/4 of NW/4 Section 12, T22S - R37E, Lea County, New Mexico. This request is for a Tubb gas well for our Hinton No. 11 well located in Unit F. A lease plat is attached showing the location of this well.

John H. Hendrix Corporation also requests administrative approval for a non-standard location for the Hinton No. 11. The Hinton No. 6 drilled in 1945 to the Paddock Pool presently is located at the standard location of 1980' FNL and 1980' FWL. The Hinton No. 11 was drilled to the Wantz Granite Wash in 1972, and is of sufficient depth to test the Tubb.

Approval of this request will protect correlative rights, promote conservation, and encourage the efficient recovery of gas reserves. The proposed proration unit consists of a single contiguous lot and lies wholly within a single governmental section. The length or width of the proration unit will not exceed 5280 feet. The well will not be located inside 330' from any lease or quarter-quarter section line.

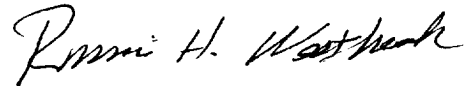

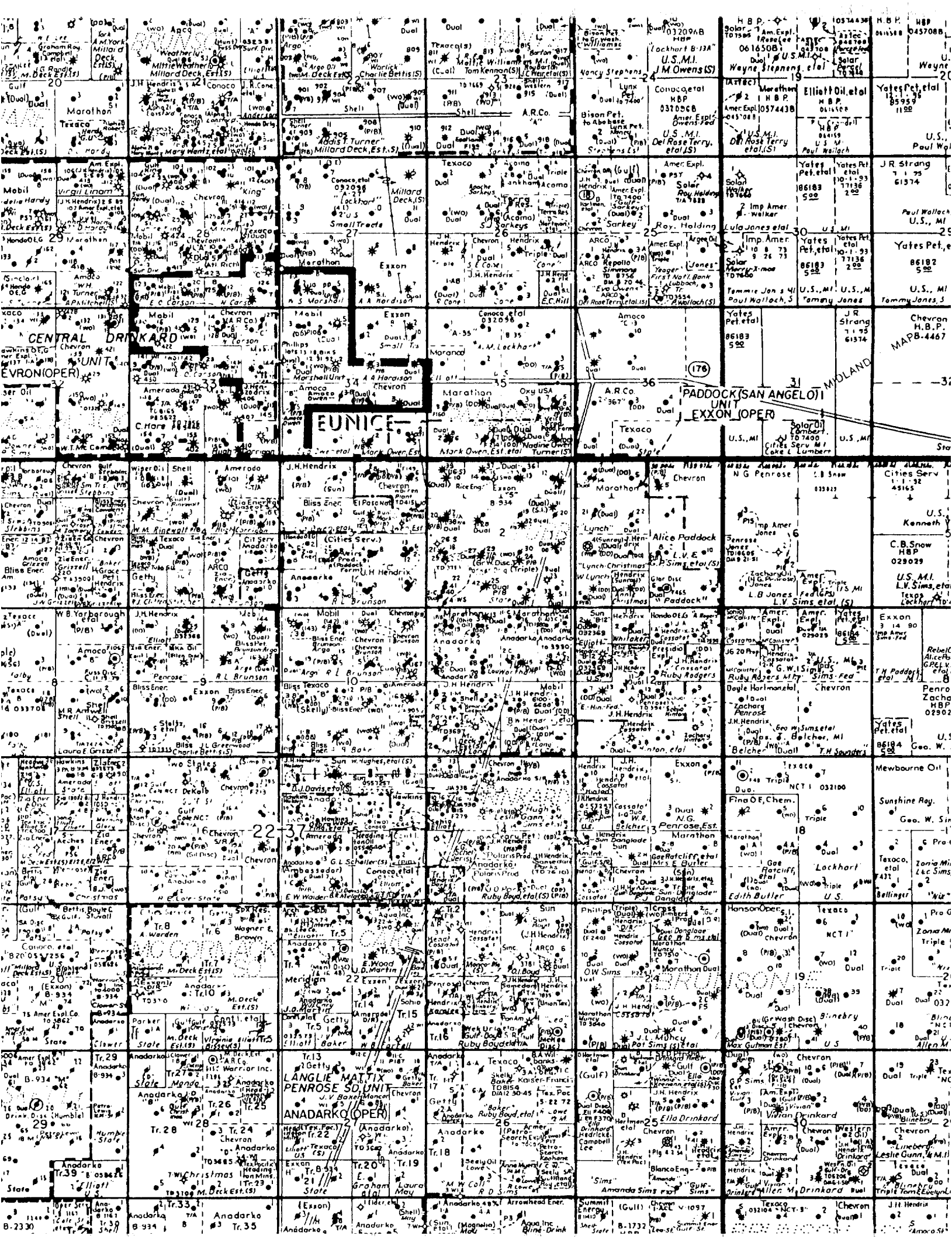
