9/19/73: Ran 2 3/8" tubing with 5 1/2" retrievable bridge plug and RTTS to 6871' and set B.P. Pulled packer to 6834' and spotted 600 gal. regular 15% acid over perfs. -6254'-6834'. Pulled packer to 6439' and set. Acidized perfs. 6449'-6834' with 4400 gal. reg. 15% NE acid using 18 balls. Max. Press. 4800#, Min. Press. 2200#, Avg. Psi 2900#. Balled out perfs. 64800#. Pulled B.P. to 6430' and packer to 6200'. Acidized perfs. 6254'-6413' with 5000 gal. reg. 15% NE acid using 18 balls. Max. press. 4000#, Min. press. 2400#, Avg. press. 3200#. Instant shut-in-1200#. Producing at a rate of 84 BOPD. Traces of water, 960 MCFPD, GOR 11429.

Instructions

General: This form is designed for submitting proposals to perform certain well operations, and reports of such operations when completed, as indicated, on Federal and Indian lands pursuant to applicable Federal law and regulations, and, if approved or accepted by any State, on all lands in such State, pursuant to applicable State law and regulations. Any necessary special instructions concerning the use of this form and the number of copies to be submitted, particularly with regard to local, area, or regional procedures and practices, either are shown below or will be issued by, or may be obtained from, the local Federal and/or State office.
