Gentlemen:

J. C. Williamson is in the process of unitizing the N/2 of the Subject Section for the purpose of deepening the Subject Well for the purpose of running a 5-1/2" OD liner to attempt production in the Strawn formation of Pennsylvanian age. The unitization is for the Pennsylvanian formations only (Atoka, Strawn and Morrow) and the original attempt is the Strawn. The proposed unit is a 320 Acre standard gas unit, but the Subject Well was surveyed in error and requires approval of an unorthodox location. The well was originally approved for Wolfcamp production only, so Williamson is requesting Administrative Approval by the District Supervisor in Hobbs.

The State Rules and Regulations require notice to all offset Operators to approve the location without a thirty day delay.
