Gentlemen:

Re: Application for authority to dually complete Marathon Oil Company's Walter Lynch Well No. 6, located in Unit F of Sec. 1, T-22S, R-37E, Lea County, New Mexico, for production of oil from the Drinkard and Wantz Granite Wash Pools.

Marathon Oil Company respectfully requests that the New Mexico Oil Conservation Commission grant administratively this application for the dual completion of Marathon Oil Company's Walter Lynch Well No. 6 for production of oil from the Drinkard and the Wantz Granite Wash Pools. Attached hereto is the New Mexico Oil Conservation Commission Form C-107, "Application for Multiple Completion", fully executed, together with a diagrammatic sketch of the multiple completion and a plat indicating, to the best of our knowledge, the location of all wells on Marathon Oil Company's lease and all offset wells, along with other supporting data required by the Commission rules.

It is Marathon's opinion that the multiple completion of the Walter Lynch Well No. 6, herein described, will effectively prevent communication between all zones, and that the approval of this dual completion will not cause waste and will not infringe upon the correlative rights of any other operator in any of the pools.

A copy of this application, along with attachments listed on New Mexico Oil Conservation Commission Form C-107 as Items 4(A), (B), & (C) have been furnished to all interested parties known to Marathon Oil Company.



NOTE: If the proposed multiple completion will result in an unorthodox well location and/or a non-standard proration unit in One or more of the producing zones, then separate application for approval of the same should be filed simultaneously with this application.
