

11. OTHER INFORMATION:

- A. Topography: Land surface is sand and mesquite - comparatively flat.
- B. Soil: Soil is shallow sand underlain by caliche.
- C. Flora and Fauna: The vegetative cover is generally sparse and consists of mesquite and wild grasses. Wildlife in the area is that typical of semi-arid desert land and includes rabbits and rodents.
- D. Ponds and streams: None in this area.
- E. Residences and Other Structures: The nearest occupied dwellings are located in the City of Eunice.
- F. ARCHEOLOGICAL, HISTORICAL AND CULTURAL SITES: None observed in this area.
- G. Land Use: Possible grazing.
- H. Surface ownership: Wellsite is on Federal surface. Grazing lessor has been contacted and approved operations as stated. Snyder Ranch.


