Gentlemen:

John H. Hendrix Corporation respectfully requests administrative approval for a non-standard location for the Drinkard Estate No. 6 in the Brunson Drinkard-Abo, S. Pool. A lease plat is attached showing the location of this well.

The Drinkard Estate No. 6 was drilled as a Wantz-Granite Wash well at a non-standard location of 1807' FWL and 1542' FEL of Section 25, T22S - R37E, Lea County, New Mexico. The non-standard location was due to the location of Drinkard Estate No. 5 and to avoid buried pipelines and an existing road in the area. It is noted that John H. Hendrix Corporation owns and operates the tract to the east of Drinkard Estate No. 6, which is the tract nearest the non-standard location. The Wantz-Granite Wash was approved by NSL-852.

The Drinkard Estate No. 6 is a replacement well in the Brunson Drinkard-Abo, S. for the Drinkard Estate No. 5 which has been squeezed in the Brunson Drinkard-Abo, S. and temporarily abandoned due to a high pressure water flow.

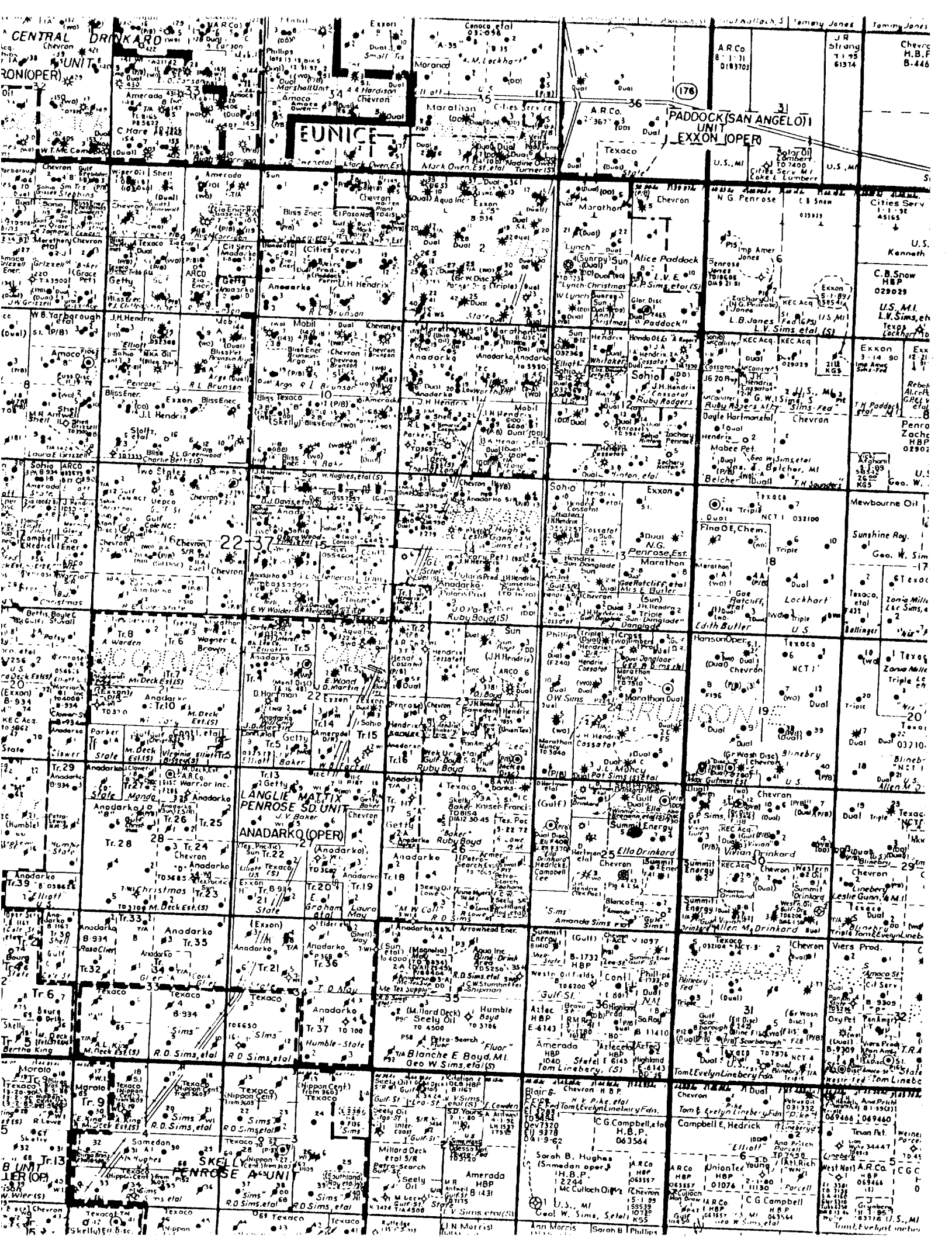
