Ladies and Gentlemen:

This is to inform you as an offset operator that Chevron U.S.A. Inc. has applied for administrative approval for an exception to Rule 303-A to permit downhole commingling of the Wantz-Abo and Wantz-Granite Wash zones in the Hugh Well No. 12.

Currently the Hugh #12 is producing from the Wantz-Abo. The Lower Wantz-Granite Wash zone is shut-in and isolated with a CIBP. Chevron is planning a workover to complete the Upper Wantz-Granite Wash zone and combine it with existing Wantz-Abo production. The proposed downhole commingling will allow continued production of the Wantz-Abo and Wantz-Granite Wash zones to a lower economic limit, thus increasing ultimate recovery.
