Gentlemen:

Chevron U.S.A. Inc. respectfully requests administrative approval for an unorthodox gas well location on the Hugh # 12.

Chevron is proposing to recomplete this well to the Wantz Abo Pool as a gas producer. This well was originally completed in the Wantz Granite Wash Pool in January of 1978. It is now shut-in due to reduced production and parted tubing.

The location is unorthodox in that it is 330' from both the south and east boundaries of the proration unit. The location of well # 12 is 2310' FNL and 330' FEL, Unit H, Section 14, T22S, R37E, Lea County, New Mexico.

In order to prevent waste, Chevron respectfully requests your approval of this administrative application for an unorthodox well location. Attached is a map showing offset operators and a C-102 plat. A copy of this letter and attachments are being furnished by Certified Mail to the offset operators as their notice of this application.
