It is proposed to PLA subject well as follows.

1. Release packer and retrieve bridge plug. Pull out of hole with tubing.
2. Go in hole with dump bailer and spot 8 sx (35') Class "H" cement with 0.3% HR-4 mixed 15.6 lb./gal. - 1.18 ft. ³/sx on top of cast iron bridge plug at 10,580'.
3. Go in hole with a 7-5/8" cement retainer on tubing and set at $\pm$ 9350'. Pressure test.
4. Pump 100 sx Class "H" with 0.3% HR-4 mixed 15.6 lb./gal. - 1.18 ft. ³/sx through retainer. Pull out of retainer and spot 8 sacks on top of retainer. Reverse out excess.
5. Circulate hole with salt gel mud weighted from 9.5 to 10.0 ppg. (brine diluted). (415 barrels hole volume).

Instructions

General: This form is designed for submitting proposals to perform certain well operations, and reports of such operations when completed, as indicated, on Federal and Indian lands pursuant to applicable Federal law and regulations, and, if approved or accepted by any State, on all lands in such State, pursuant to applicable State law and regulations. Any necessary special instructions concerning the use of this form and the number of copies to be submitted, particularly with regard to local, area, or regional procedures and practices, either are shown below or will be issued by, or may be obtained from, the local Federal and/or State office.

Item 4: If there are no applicable State requirements, locations on Federal or Indian land should be described in accordance with Federal requirements. Consult local State or Federal office for specific instructions.

Item 17: Proposals to abandon a well and subsequent reports of abandonment should include such special information as is required by local Federal and/or State offices. In addition, such proposals and reports should include reasons for the abandonment; data on any former or present productive zones, or other zones with present significant fluid contents not sealed off by cement or otherwise; depths (top and bottom) and method of placement of cement plugs; mud or other material placed below, between and above plugs; amount, size, method of parting of any casing, liner or tubing pulled and the depth to top of any left in the hole; method of closing top of well; and date well site conditioned for final inspection looking to approval of the abandonment.

6. Pull out of hole with tubing.
7. Prepare to cut-off and pull 7-5/8" casing. Top of cement by temperature survey is 6800'. Pick-up on 7-5/8" casing and determine free point.
8. Go in hole and shoot casing off 50' above free point. Rig up casing pulling crew. Pull and lay down 7-5/8" casing.
9. Go in hole with tubing open ended and spot 50 sacks Class "C" cement mixed 14.8 lb./gal. 1.32 ft.³/sx with 2% CaCl₂ from 75' below 7-5/8" casing cut-off point to 75' above cut-off point.
10. Spot a 40 sack Class "C" cement plug mixed 14.8 lb./gal. - 1.32 ft.³/sx with 2% CaCl₂ from 5157' to 5057'. (10-3/4" casing shoe.)
11. Spot a 41 sack Class "C" cement plug mixed 14.8 lb./gal. - 1.32 ft.³/sx with 2% CaCl₂ from 4960' to 4860'. (Base of salt)
12. Spot a 41 sack Class "C" cement plug mixed 14.8 lb./gal. - 1.32 ft.³/sx with 2% CaCl₂ from 1520' to 1420'. (Top of salt)
13. Spot a 25 sack Class "C" cement plug mixed 14.8 lb./gal. - 1.32 ft.³/sx with 2% CaCl₂ from 50' to surface and erect a dry hole marker.
