SURFACE USE PLAN Conoco, Inc.

Meyer B-31 A Nos. 4 and 5 Sec. 31-22S-36E

The plan is to accompany "Application for Permit to Drill" the subject well. The following is a discussion of pertinent information concerning possible effects which the proposed drilling of the well may have on the environment of the well and road sites and surrounding acreage. A copy will be posted on the derrick floor so all contractors and sub-contractors will be aware of all items of this plan.

1. Existing Roads

- A. The proposed well sites are:
 No. 4 660' FNL and 660' FEL, Sec. 31, T-22S, R-36E, Lea County,
 New Mexico
 No. 5 660' FNL and 1980' FWL, Sec. 31, T-22S, R-36E, Lea County,
 New Mexico
- B. Exhibit A is a portion of a New Mexico road map showing existing roads. Directions to the location are as follows: Travel south on Loop 18 out of Eunice, New Mexico, and turn west on the Delaware Basin Road following it for 12 miles. Turn east on the caliche road to the Meyer B-31 A lease.
- C. Access roads are shown on Exhibits B and C.
- D. No improvement or maintenance is anticipated for the existing roads.

2. Planned Access Roads

- A. Width and Length: New roads required will be 16' wide and various in length. These new roads are labeled and coded on Exhibits B and C.
- B. Turnouts: One
- C. Drainage Design: New roads will have a drop of 6" from center line on each side.
- D. Culverts, Cuts and Fills: No major culverts, cuts, or fills are required.
- E. Surfacing Material: Six inches of caliche, bladed, watered and compacted.
- F. Gates, Cattleguards and Fences: None required.
