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10. PLANS FOR RESTORATION OF THE SURFACE

- A. After finishing drilling and/or completion operations, all equipment and other material not needed for further operations will be removed. The location will be cleaned of all trash and junk to leave the wellsite in as aesthetically pleasing a condition as possible.
- B. Unguarded pits, if any, containing fluids will be fenced until they have been filled.
- C. If the proposed well is non-productive, all rehabilitation and/or vegetation requirements of the Landowner-Operator agreement will be complied with and will be accomplished as expeditiously as possible. All pits will be leveled within 90 days after abandonment.
- 11. OTHER INFORMATION
 - A. Topography: the land surface in the vicinity of the wellsite is fairly flat. The immediate area of the wellsite is discussed above in paragraph 9B.
 - B. Flora and Fauna: the vegetation cover consists of mesquite, saltbush, sand sage, shimmery oak and other miscellaneous desert growth. The wildlife in area probably includes those typical of semi-arid desert land. The area is used for cattle grazing.
 - C. There are no ponds, lakes or rivers in the area.
 - D. There are no inhabited dwellings in the vicinity of the proposed well.
 - E. Surface ownership: the wellsite is on state surface.
 - F. There is no evidence of any archeological, historical or cultural sites in the area.
- 12. OPERATOR'S REPRESENTATIVE
