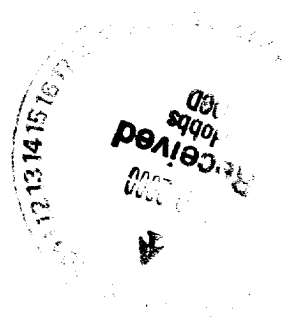


Dear Mr. Wink:

The purpose of this letter is to report the clean-up of loose material and equipment on the subject lease. The No. 1 well was originally drilled by Estoril Producing Corporation but was later acquired by Williamson et al and abandoned after Curry Resources re-entered the well and completed it as a Bone Springs oil well. The well developed some water problems and was not produced for some time. An attempt to repair the well several years ago was unsuccessful and some of the surface equipment was damaged through use. We recently cleaned up the location, re-set the pumping unit and worked on the tank battery with the purpose in mind to produce the well for drilling brine; however, we have since decided to plug back the well to re-complete in the Delaware as an oil producer. This program is not scheduled until later in the fourth quarter when the proper forms will be submitted.

All loose material and equipment except a string of rods belonging to this operation was picked up and stored in the yard and warehouse located in Unit J, Section 15. We expect to pick up the rods and store them in the warehouse as soon as equipment is in the area working on some of the other wells

This lease consists of the S/2 SW/4 from the surface to the base of the Bone Springs formation and is federal minerals with the Surface administered by the State Land Office as Trustee and the grazing rights have either been assigned to the Keller Ranch or are leased by them.
