
The purpose of this letter is to report the clean-up of loose material and equipment on the subject lease. The No. 1 well was originally drilled by Belco Petroleum Corp. but was later acquired by Williamson and Curry, who re-entered the well, ran a liner and attempted to complete in the Delaware as an oil well. The attempt was unsuccessful and operations were shut in.

San Simon Water Disposal Company, Inc., submitted a proposal to re-complete this well as a Salt Water Disposal Well, which was approved by the BLM and the OCD. Operations has not commenced on this project and will not begin until such time San Simon has modified their existing system to comply with planned changes. The well is a necessary back-up to San Simon's operations and will be implemented in the future.

Some loose material and equipment, including a string of rods belonging to this operation was picked up and stored in the yard and warehouse located in Unit J, Section 15. We expect to pick up the five joints of casing on the location and remove them to the warehouse when equipment is in the area.

This lease consists of the S/2 SE/4 from the surface to the base of the Bone Springs formation and are owned by EOG Resources with the deep rights assigned to the Mid-Continent operated Belco Federal, Well No. 1 Pennsylvanian proration unit located in Unit P that comprises all of the S/2 of this Section. The Oil and Gas lease is federal minerals with the Surface administered by the State Land Office as Trustee and the grazing rights leased to the Keller Ranch.
