APPLICATION OF RAY WESTALL

**ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER
OF THE OIL CONSERVATION DIVISION**

Under the provisions of Rule 701(B), Ray Westall made application to the New Mexico Oil Conservation Division on January 14, 1993, for permission to complete for salt water disposal its Federal "30" Well No. 2 located 330 feet from the South line and 1650 feet from the East line (Unit O) of Section 30, Township 23 South, Range 34 East, NMPM, Lea County, New Mexico.

THE DIVISION DIRECTOR FINDS THAT:

- (1) The application has been duly filed under the provisions of Rule 701(B) of the Division Rules and Regulations;
- (2) Satisfactory information has been provided that all offset operators and surface owners have been duly notified;
- (3) The applicant has presented satisfactory evidence that all requirements prescribed in Rule 701 will be met; and
- (4) No objections have been received within the waiting period prescribed by said rule.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED THAT:

The applicant herein, Ray Westall is hereby authorized to complete its Federal "30" Well No. 2 located 330 feet from the South line and 1650 feet from the East line (Unit O) of Section 30, Township 23 South, Range 34 East, NMPM, Lea County, New Mexico, in such manner as to permit the injection of salt water for disposal purposes into the Delaware formation at approximately 8198 feet to 8457 through 2 7/8 inch plastic lined tubing set in a packer located at approximately 8100 feet.
