Dear Mr. Stogner:

Exxon Corp. requests administrative approval of an Unorthodox Location for the J. L. Greenwood #16 based on Rule 104 F,1 "the recompletion of a well previously drilled to a deeper horizon, provided said well was drilled at an orthodox or approved unorthodox location for such original horizon". The #16 was previously an oil completion at an orthodox location in the Paddock. Presently, the #16 is an oil completion in the Blinebry Oil and Gas Pool. Approval has been requested to add Blinebry perforations, acidize and frac. Adding Blinebry perforations will cause this well to go from an oil well to a gas well and therefore be at an unorthodox location in the Blinebry (Pro Gas) (Consolidated).

The J. L. Greenwood #13 is presently completed in the Blinebry (Pro Gas) (Consolidated). Both #13 and #16 are located in the SW/4 of Section 9, T22S-R37E, Lea County, Unit Letters L and N, respectively. Administrative approval is requested to Simultaneously Dedicate the SW/4 160 acres, to both the #13 and #16.

A list of the offset operators that have been notified and a copy of the letter and certified return receipts are enclosed. We have requested that they execute a waiver and send one copy to the N.M.O.C.D and one copy to Exxon.

Administrative Order NSC-3220 (SD) authorized the unorthodox location of well #9 and simultaneous dedication of wells #9 and #11 in the SE4, 160 acres, of Section 9, T22S-R37E.

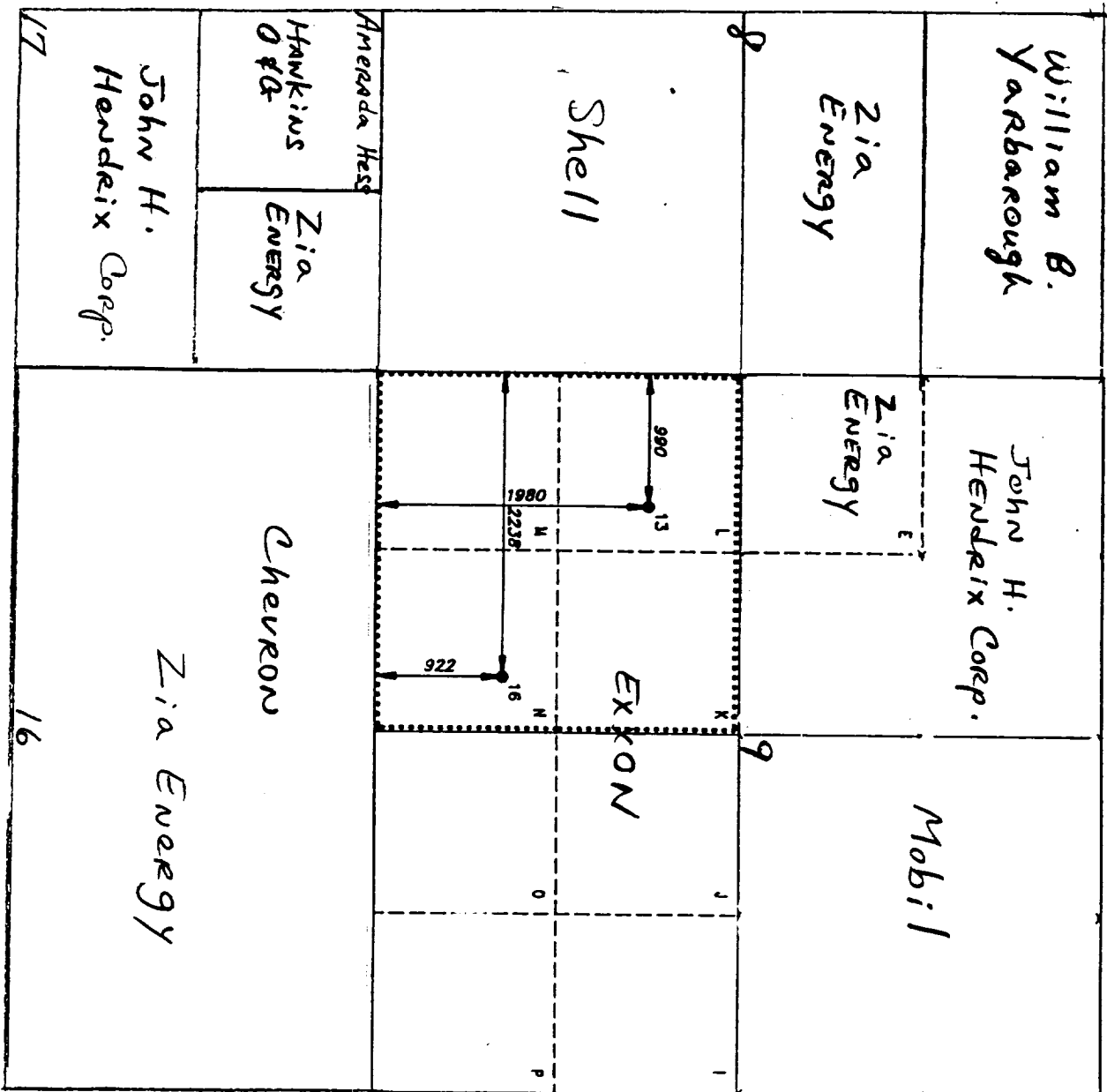
