Dear Mr. Stogner:

BTA hereby requests administrative approval to plug back and test the Atoka formation in the above referenced well. This well was completed as a marginal Morrow producer 3/19/93 and is uneconomical to operate at less than 100 MCF per day.

BTA recompleted the Hudson State, Well No. 1-Y, which is an Atoka producer and located 860' FNL & 1980' FWL, in April, 1988. This well currently produces at a rate of 450 MCF per day and will be "<u>Shut In</u>" upon a successful completion of well No. 2 in the Atoka formation.

All offset operators and mineral owners have been notified and furnished a copy of our application by certified mail. Please advise, should further information be required to grant this application.
