In accordance with NTL-2B, the following is hereby submitted for your review and approval as the water disposal method for the Bonanza Federal #1:

1. Produced water is from the Delaware formation.
2. Approximately 100 barrels of water are produced per day.
3. Produced water is collected and stored in a fiberglass tank on the Bonanza Federal #1 location, and transferred via 3" poly pipe to the Antelope Ridge Unit #5 SWD well.
4. The Antelope Ridge Unit #5 SWD-578 well is operated by Strata Production Company and is located 2310' FSL & 990' FWL of Section 33, Township 23 South, Range 34 East, Lea County, New Mexico.
5. No pits are installed on the location.
6. Alternate produced water disposal method includes trucked by Steve Carter, Loco Hills Disposal Systems.
