Dear Ms. Anderson:

Reference is made to your application dated June 22, 2000 for a 79.86-acre non-standard gas spacing and proration unit consisting of the following acreage in the Undesignated Eumont Gas Pool:

LEA COUNTY, NEW MEXICO <u>TOWNSHIP 22 SOUTH, RANGE 37 EAST, NMPM</u> Section 4: Lot 3 and the SE/4 NW/4.

This unit is to be dedicated to Apache Corporation's existing Rinewalt Well No. 5 (API No. 30-025-34582), located at an unorthodox gas well location 510 feet from the North line and 1980 feet from the West line (Lot 3/Unit C) of Section 4.

This application has been duly filed under the provisions of Division Rule 104.F, revised by Division Order No. R-11231, issued by the New Mexico Oil Conservation Commission in Case No. 12119 on August 12, 1999.

By authority granted me under the provisions Rule 2(d) of the "Special Rules and Regulations for the Eumont Gas Pool", as promulgated by Division Order No. R-8170, as amended, and Division Rules 104.D and 104.F (2), the above-described 79.86-acre non-standard GPU and unorthodox Eumont gas well location for the above-described Rinewalt Well No. 5 are hereby approved.

Further, Apache Corporation is permitted to produce the allowable assigned this 79.86-acre nonstandard gas spacing and proration unit in accordance with Rule 5 of the Eumont special pool rules from this well.
