## DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

Hole was drilled to depth of 2780', in Brown Lime, and 8-5/8" 24# Second hand casing was run to depth of 2750'. Casing was cemented with 1600 sac of 3% Aquagel cement and 100 sac of regular.

When plug had reached a depth of 1880', casing split and allowed cement to circulate back into cellar. Went in hole with bit on March 5, 1951 and drilled window in casing at depth of 1880'. Will drill new hole through window from this depth and continue to projected total depth.
