Set and cemented at 1450' with 745 sacks of 2% Jel bulk cement. Plug at 1416'. Cement circulated. Job complete at 3:45 p.m. July 7, 1951.

Propose to drill plug and test shut-off at 3:45 a. m. July 9, 1951.
