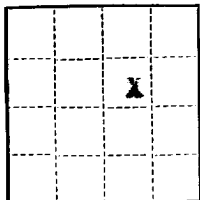

## DETAILS OF WORK

It is our intention to drill a well at the above location to an approximate depth of 5100' to attempt a completion in the Delaware horizon. All casing points will be cemented in accordance with approved methods of the U.S.G.S. and any special requirements will be complied with.

It is planned to use the following casing patterns: 11" hole, 7 5/8" casing to be set at 350' and cemented with 175 sacks cement. Cement is to circulate. 6 3/4" hole, 4 1/2" casing to be set at 5100' and cemented with 200 sacks. Cement is to return to 3700'.

Permission is requested to produce the well upon completion.
