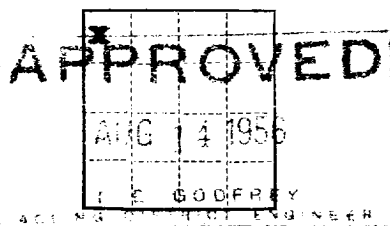

DETAILS OF WORK

It is intended to drill this well with rotary tools at the above location to an approximate TD of 4325'. Casing will be cemented in accordance with USGS standards and other special requirements will be complied with.

The following casing pattern is planned: 8 5/8" OD set at 1000' with 350 sacks, cement to be circulated to surface, 5 1/2" OD set at 4325' with 250 sacks.

Permission is requested to produce this well upon completion.

Drilling program is identical with that already approved for the former location.

I understand that this plan of work must receive approval in writing by the Geological Survey before operations may be commenced.
