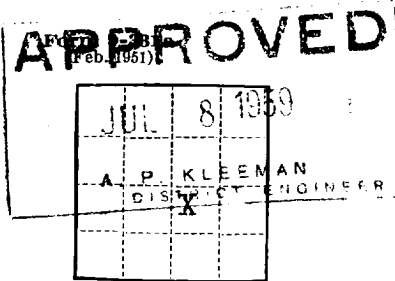

DETAILS OF WORK

It is intended to drill a well at the above location with rotary tools to an estimated TD of 4710'. Casing will be cemented in accordance with USGS standards and other special requirements will be complied with.

The following casing pattern is planned: 3 5/8" OD set at 700' with approximately 400 sacks, cement to circulate; 4 1/2" OD set at TD 4710' with approximately 170 sacks, cement to return to 4000'.

I understand that this plan of work must receive approval in writing by the Geological Survey before operations may be commenced.
