DETAILS OF WORK

It is intended to drill a well at the above location with rotory tools to a depth of 4670' in the Delaware Sand. Casing will be cemented in accordance with USGS regulations and other special requirements will be complied with.

The following casing program is planned: 7 5/8" OD set at 350' with 175 sacks, cement to circulate to surface; 4 1/2" OD set at 4670' with 175 sacks, cement to return to 4000'.

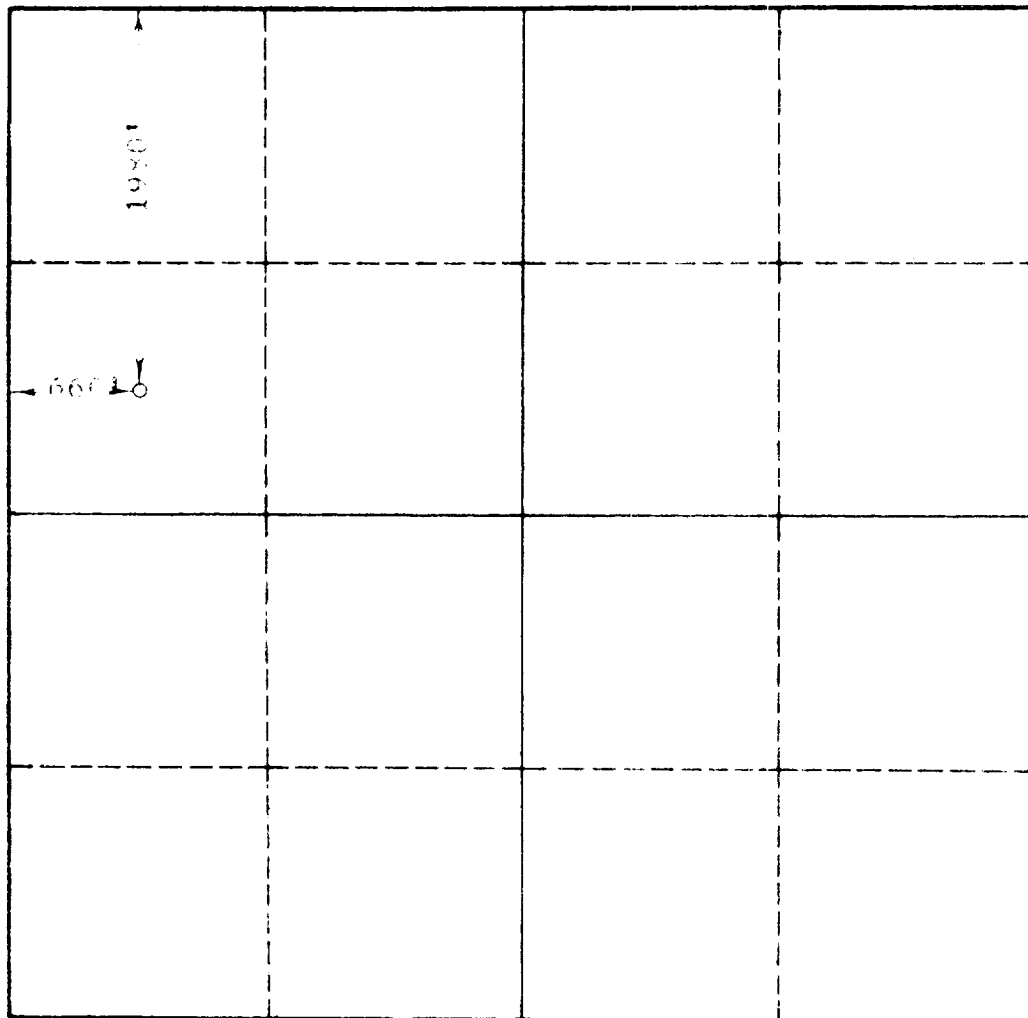
