Instructions

General: This form is designed for submitting proposals to perform certain well operations, and reports of such operations when completed, as indicated, on Federal and Indian lands. It is to be filled out by the party that negotiates and, if approved or accepted by any State, on all lands in such State, pursuant to applicable State law and regulations. Each proposal must be accompanied by a copy of the State law and regulations governing the use of this form and the number of copies to be submitted, particularly with regard to local, State, or regional agencies and departments. All proposals must be submitted to the local Federal and/or State office.

Item 4: If there are no applicable State requirements, locations on Federal or Indian land should be described in accordance with Federal requirements. Consult local State or Federal office for more information.

Item 17: Proposals to abandon a well must include special information as is required by local Federal and/or State offices. In addition, such proposals and reports should include reasons for the abandonment; data on any former or present productive zones, or other zones with present significant hydrocarbons or other fluids; and the location and method of placement of cement plugs; mud or other material placed below; and date well site was plugged; amount, size, method of placement of any casing, liner or tubing pulled and the depth to top of any left in the hole; method of closing top of well; and date well site was abandoned for final disposal. Proposals should be submitted to the local Federal and/or State office for approval.

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
