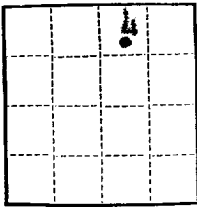

DETAILS OF WORK

Proposal is to re-enter Federal Elliott "B" well No. 1 drilled in November, 1959 by Frank O. Elliott. Surface casing is still intact at 308 feet. 4-1/2" O.D. 11.50 pound casing will be set at approximately 1460 feet and cemented with 125 sacks of cement. Casing will be perforated opposite Delaware formation. Formation will then be acidized and fractured through the casing. Approximate re-entry date March 15, 1960.

I understand that this plan of work must receive approval in writing by the Geological Survey before operations may be commenced.
