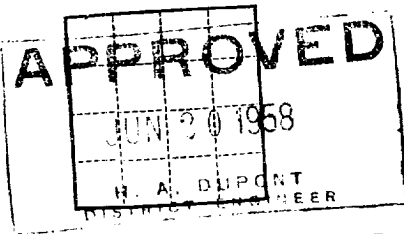

approval as to amount of cement to be used.

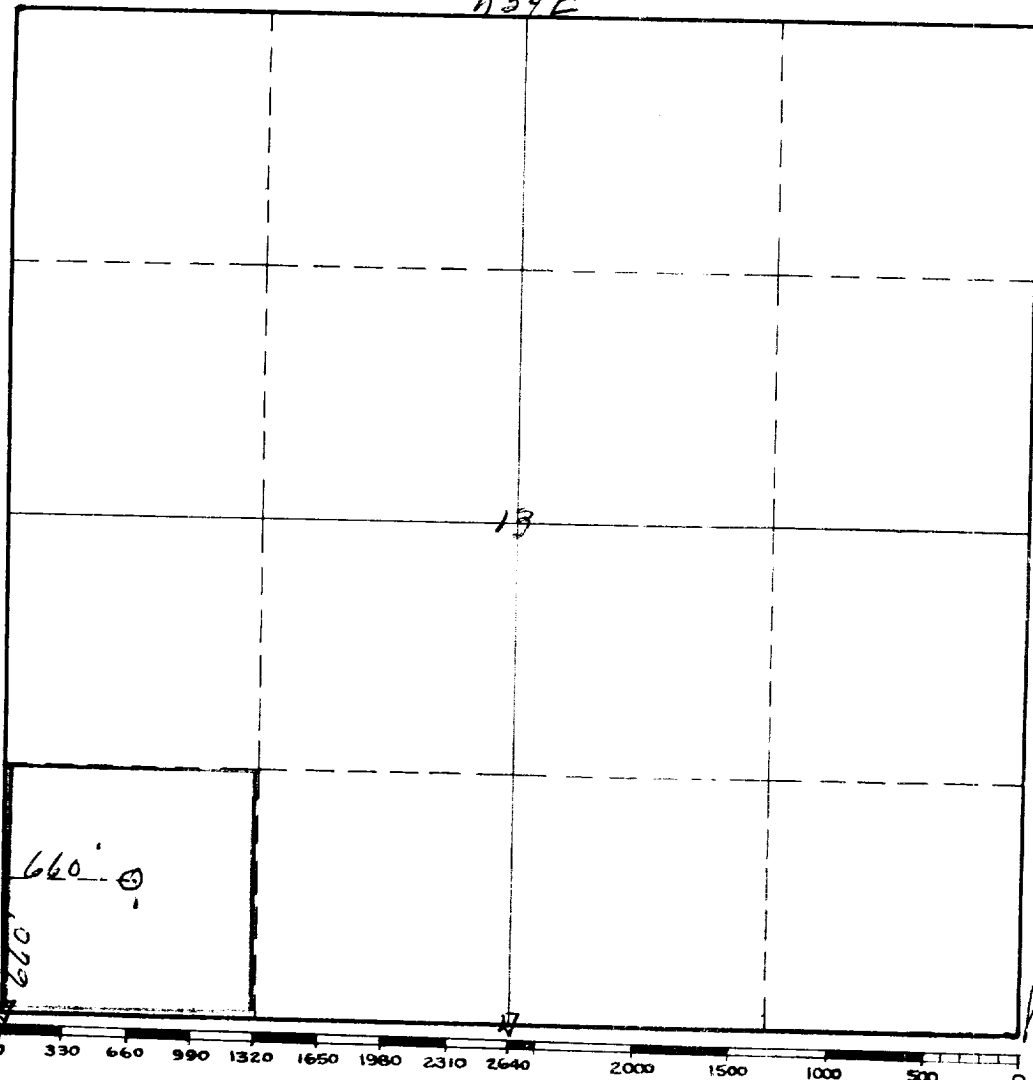
