DETAILS OF WORK

We propose to drill this well to the approximate total depth of 12,500'. Casing program planned to be 370' of 13-3/8" 40# surface casing using 200 sacks of cement. Cement to circulate to surface, 5082' of 9-5/8" 40# casing for intermediate string using 500 sacks of cement, 2-Stage, cement to set 48 hrs. run 11,691' of 7" 29# casing oil string using 250 sacks of cement, 2-Stage, cement to set for 22 Hrs.

I understand that this plan of work must receive approval in writing by the Geological Survey before operations may be commenced.
