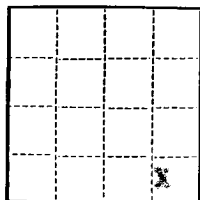

## DETAILS OF WORK

Drilled from surface to 310' w/12 1/2" hole, ran 8 5/8", 24' casing set @ 309, cemented w/175 sacks Lone Star Reg. Cement; cement circulated to outside of surface, allowed to set 18 hours, nipples up, tested w/1000 cold water pressure for 30 minutes prior to drilling plug. No decline in pressure.
