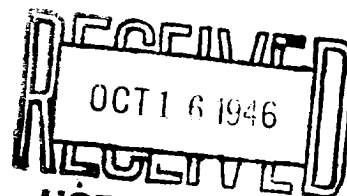

Run 245' of 10" pipe set @ 255' cemented w/200 sacks, Sept. 17, 1946. Drilled plug and tested casing w/500# pump pressure before and after drilling plug. Tested O. K. Sept. 18, 1946.

Run 2813' of 7-5/8" pipe set @ 2825' cemented w/250 sacks Sept. 25, 1946. Drilled plug and tested casing w/1000# pump pressure before and after drilling plug. O.K. 9-27-1946.

Run 3435' of 5 1/2" pipe set @ 3445' cemented w/125 sacks, Oct. 2, 1946. Drilled plug and tested casing w/1000# pump pressure before and after drilling plug, 10-5-1946 - Tested O.K.
