- 2.) Cleaned out 3502-3643' PERD.
- 3.) Perforated 5-1/2" OD casing 3426-3430' with 4 shots, and 3434-3440' with 6 shots total of 10 shots.
- 4.) Treated perfs. 3426-3440' with 1500 gallons 15% HCl acid and 300# rock salt.
- 5.) Ran 312 inches (25'1") 2-3/8" OD EUE 8 Rd tubing and set at 3616'.
- 6.) Pump tested perforations 3312-3472 and open hole 3472-3643' for 168 hours. 26 barrels oil, 311 barrels load water.
- 7.) Returned well to active status February 1, 1977 pumping Lanlie-Mattix perfs. 3312-3472' and open hole 3472-3643' for 2 barrels oil, 20 barrels load water per day.

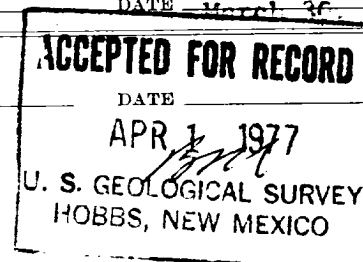

Instructions

General: This form is designed for submitting proposals to perform certain well operations, and reports of such operations when completed, as indicated, on Federal and Indian lands pursuant to applicable Federal law and regulations, and, if approved or accepted by any State, on all lands in such State, pursuant to applicable State law and regulations. Any necessary special instructions concerning the use of this form and the number of copies to be submitted, particularly with regard to local, area, or regional procedures and practices, either are shown below or will be issued by, or may be obtained from, the local Federal and/or State office.

Item 1: If there are no applicable State requirements, locations on Federal or Indian land should be described in accordance with Federal requirements. Consult local State or Federal office for specific instructions.

Item 2: Proposals to abandon a well and subsequent reports of abandonment should include such special information as is required by local Federal and/or State offices. In addition, such proposals and reports should include reasons for the abandonment; data on any former or present productive zones, or other zones with present significant fluid content not sealed off by cement or otherwise; depths (top and bottom) and method of placement of cement plugs; mud or other material placed below, between and above plugs; amount, size, method of parting of any casing, liner or tubing pulled and the depth to top of any left in the hole; method of closing top of well; and date well site conditioned for final inspection looking to approval of the abandonment.
