DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

Well completed July 29. Flowed approximately 250 bbls with 1 1/2 MCU. Ft. gas in 24 hrs. Assumed circulating oil fully recovered and on July 30 flowed 67 bbls. in 8 hrs., which was reported to proration office as potential. Flow decreased to 2 bbls. per hr. on August 4, on which date well was shot with 130 qts. solidified glycerine from 3508-3610. Well bridged following shot; cleaned out from August 6 to August 14. Tested August 16, 35 bbls. in 24 hrs.; well then shut in.
