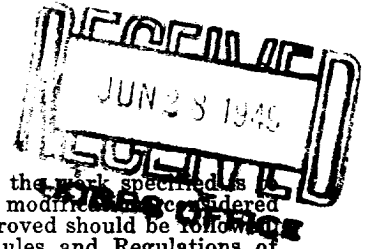

This well was drilled to a total depth of 3620' showing Suphur water. 8 5/8 casing was cemented at 1235' and cemented with 500 sacks and cemented to the top. We intend to plug and abandon same, Plugging with 50 sacks of cement in bottom of hole and 25 sacks in bottom of 8 5/8 casing and leaving regulating marker in top of hole.
