Squeezed perforations 3317-3328' w/150 sacks cement w/2% calcium chloride w/1/2# tuff plug per sack. Maximum squeeze pressure 3,000#. Drilled cement plug 3200-3328'. Open hole 3328-3336'. Drilled cement retainer at 3336' and cement to 3355'. Open hole 3355-3370'. Drilled bridge plug at 3370' and cement to 3400'. Open hole 3400-3458'. New PBD 3496' (plug set in original completion). Set packer at 3350'. Treated perforations 3388-3415' w/1,000 gallons 15% acid. Pulled tubing and packer. Ran tubing with bull plug at 3413' and seating nipple at 3382'. Swabbed well off. On test 2-2-67, flowed 72 barrels oil, 11 barrels water, with 202 MCFG in 24 hours. GOR 2,806.

Work started 1-26-67 and completed 2-1-67.

Instructions
