DETAILS OF WORK

This well was recompleted during the early part of this month by plugging back to 3580 feet and perforating the Basal Yates zone from 3550 to 3574 feet. After 500 gallons of acid, the well was potentialed for 7.1 barrels of oil on a 10 hour test on July 10, 1959. Since the production has declined to about 2 barrels per day, we plan to frac with 10,000 gallons and 10,000 pounds of sand in an effort to increase the production from the well.

I understand that this plan of work must receive approval in writing by the Geological Survey before operations may be commenced.
