FOLLOW INSTRUCTIONS IN THE RULES AND REGULATIONS OF THE COMMISSION

Whitten #2 has casing cemented at 3550', open hole from 3550 to 3625'. Propose to run gamma ray and neutron survey and plug back with cement from T. B. to 3550' and test. If water shut-off is not obtained, cement back to 3550' and test. Acidize if advisable. If open hole plug back is not effective will attempt oil or gas completion by perforating casing as justified by gamma ray. This well is now dead and is so carried on proration schedule.
